

Lara Tennis Club - Court Rules

Keys

Keys are available from, and must be returned to, the nominated persons as listed on the Clubroom window

Shoes

Correct tennis shoes must be worn during play. Joggers and other footwear with irregular sole and heel surfaces must not be worn.

Courts

Courts and surrounds must be watered before play, wept and watered after play, or as required.

Property

Proper care must be taken with all Club property, eg. Nets, brooms, rollers, hoses, etc.

Bicycles

Please ensure that all bicycles are either parked in the rack provided, or are rested up against the fence or Clubrooms.

Motor Vehicles

Please drive at a safe speed when within the bounds of the court areas, especially watch for children running out from parked car areas.

General Housekeeping

There are rubbish bins provided both outside and inside the Clubrooms, please use them. Between courts and outside fences are not areas for throwing rubbish.

Alcohol

It is against the law to consume alcohol in or about the Clubrooms, except in accordance with the Licence displayed on the Notice Board. Please don't break the law.

Unsupervised Children

No unsupervised children are allowed within the fenced boundaries of the courts. We do not wish to have an accident and cause injury to any child.

Court Behaviour

We all play tennis for the enjoyment of the sport. Sportsman-like behaviour must be practiced at all times.

For Safety

Drink bottles and cans are not to be taken onto the courts.
